Riesling

Riesling is a great friend of Southeast Asian & The Malaya's cuisine. The acidity, freshness, generally lower alcohol, and (sometimes) sweetness work to temper the chilli heat, while the tangy citrus flavours, floral aromatics and minerality compliment the intense and spice-driven flavour profiles.

We've assembled a selection of some of our favourite rieslings in a range of styles styles from bone-dry Australian icons to benchmark sweet German Auslese and many inbetween.

A hallmark of great riesling is the ability to balance sweetness with acidity to enhance complexity and intensity with neither feeling out of place - a quality exemplified beautifully in the sweeter wines below.

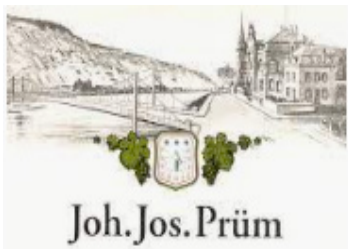


Founded in 1597, the Burklin-Wolf estate of Wachenheim in the Pfalz makes some of Germany's and the world's best dry rieslings from their vast array of Grand Cru (G.C.) and Premier Cru (P.C.) vineyards. Their wines show restrained power - remarkable body and richness with a depth of flavour than tend towards riper fruit, dried herbal complexity and grippy phenolic structure.

A legendary estate in the Mosel Valley, Joh. Jos. Prum is the benchmark estate of the region. Their wines display an uncanny combination of lightness, elegance, but also power and high voltage energy. They are light in body, but intense in flavour with laser focused acidity that transcends all three levels of sweetness. Of the two flagship vineyards, Wehlener Sonnenuhr usually shows more ripe and stonefruit flavours while Graacher Himmelreich shows more on the citrus spectrum.

Spatlese – late harvest sweet wines with more weight and intensity.
